What?

The Park Celtic Soccer Camp 2010 is a continuation of our highly successful camp that has run for nine years.

It aims to provide boys and girls with an opportunity to improve their basic skills at two levels.

At a basic level, for children between the ages of 7 and 10 years, to improve their soccer skills in a fun-filled environment. The emphasis is on improving elemental skills with a range of games, drills and 7 a side matches.

For boys and girls aged between 11 and 14 years of age the camp will be structured as a pre-season training camp – with each day broken into sessions, commencing with training each morning and ending with an afternoon match with tactical/positioning coaching. The camp for older boys and girls focuses on fitness, ball skills and positional play for various positions.

The camp is run by professionally qualified coaches using the latest training aids and equipment.

Where & When?

The Soccer Camp will run for one week only – Monday 16th August to Friday 20th August; commencing at 10.00am each day and finishing at 3.00pm.

The venue is Park Celtic pitches in Cabinteely Park.
